## LOCAL MAYORS ENDORSE SUOZZI

Bipartisan group applauds Suozzi for reaching across the aisle to get things done

*Glen Cove, NY* - Today, a bipartisan group of mayors, five Democrats and five Republicans, endorsed Tom Suozzi in his bid to reclaim the 3rd Congressional District.

"Today's endorsement makes it clear that this race is not about Democrat vs. Republican or Republican vs. Democrat. These mayors understand that this race will be about who knows the district best and who will deliver results for the people in the 3rd Congressional District," **said Suozzi.**
