#### Tom's Record as a Member of Congress

- Tom co-sponsored every gun violence prevention bill, including bills to require the universal background checks that the vast majority of Americans want.

## Tom's Record as Nassau County Executive

- Tom reduced crime while stabilizing costs by reforming procedures, deploying resources more wisely, and increasing the use of technology.

### Tom's Record as Mayor of Glen Cove

- Tom increased the police force and reduced the crime rate by 34%.
