Suozzi Releases New Ad Ahead of Special Election: "Hide"

New digital ad highlights Pilip's embrace of the Conservative Party extreme platform

Glen Cove, NY - Former Congressman Tom Suozzi, today released his newest ad ahead of the February 13th special election. The ad, entitled "Hide," will begin airing today on digital.

The ad highlights not only Pilip's perpetual hiding from the press but, in her own words, the Nassau County Conservative party endorsing her because of what "[she] stands for."
